Plenty of food and beautiful flowers were displayed throughout the Church in celebration.







We wish you many more Happy Birthdays Doreen.





Giving children and older people the opportunity to enjoy time together; forging friendships, learning from one another and making memories.






During each session all ages will enjoy games, puzzles, building, craft, colouring and conversation.


